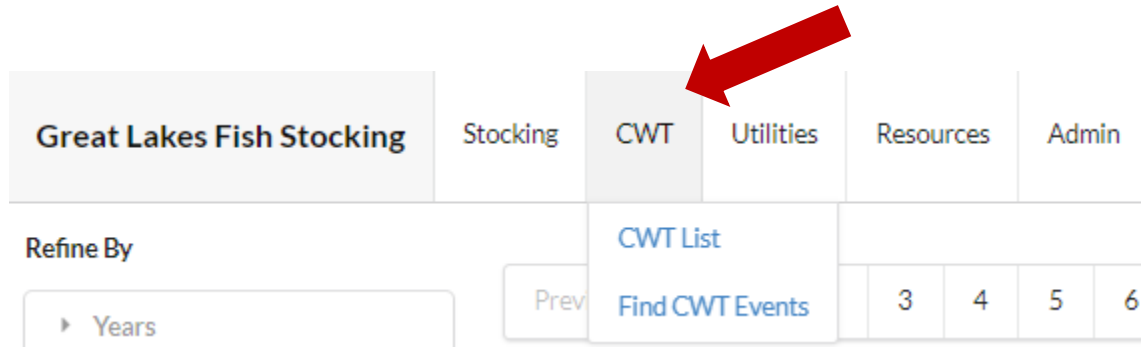


GLFSD: How to Look Up Coded Wire Tags (CWT)

There are two ways to look up specific CWTs within the stocking database website. Both paths are accessible through the CWT tab that is found in the upper left-hand corner of the website.



Path 1: "CWT List"

This provides a list of all CWTs that have been used in the Great Lakes. Like other aspects of the site, you can further refine by various filters (Years, Lakes, States/Province, etc) that are found on the left-hand side of the screen. Once you have found the specific CWT you are seeking, you can click on the tag number (blue hyperlink) to find where and when it was used, including if that code was used in more than 1 species or strain or multiple year classes.

Clicking on the number will bring up a table of information associated with that CWT. Clicking on individual Stocking ID will take you to that specific stocking event's information.

Path 2: "Find CWT Events"

If you know the specific tag number (or multiple tags), you can use the "Find CWT Events" option under the CWT Tab at the top of the page to search for individual or multiple (separated by a comma) tag numbers. If there are results matching your search, it will display an interactive map showing stocking locations and provide a list of stocking events. From here you can click on the tag numbers to learn more about that tag (if it was used multiple times) and associated stocking events. If no results are returned, please check your tag number.
